Any user who violates LAPS' "Acceptable Use Guidelines" may be denied access to the technology, and may be subject to disciplinary action. Written parent permission is necessary for each and every student that intends to use this technology. All students will be given a user consent form to be signed by parents before student can access any electronic information systems.

INTERNET USE

ACCEPTABLE USE GUIDELINES

Use of the computers must be in support of education and research consistent with the mission of Life Academy of Puget Sound. System components, including hardware or software shall not be destroyed, modified, or abused in any way. Malicious use of the system to develop programs or institute practices that harass other users, or gain unauthorized access to any programs is prohibited. Users are responsible for the appropriateness and content of material they transmit, publish, or access on the system.

Student subscription to mailing lists, bulletin boards, and any other commercial and/or information services must be pre-approved by the classroom supervisor. User files and communications on the system are not private or confidential. LAPS reserves the right to monitor, access, use, and disclose email or other information for any reason.

System accounts are to be used by the authorized owner of the account only. Users shall not share their account identification or password with another person or leave an open file or session unattended or unsupervised. Account owners are ultimately responsible for all activity under their account name. Users may not borrow passwords belonging to others, or misrepresent themselves or other users to gain unauthorized access to the system. Personal information such as addresses and telephone numbers shall remain confidential when communicating on the system. Students should never reveal any personal information without permission from a teacher and/or parent. Students shall never make appointments to meet people in person that they have contacted on the system without specific permission. Students shall notify a teacher, parent, or any other adult if they come across information or messages that are dangerous, illegal, inappropriate, or make them feel uncomfortable. To the best of their ability the staff will monitor the students use of the Internet at school and take reasonable measures to prevent access by minors to inappropriate material. The school reserves the right to determine whether specific uses of the system are consistent with these guidelines. LAPS may revoke access to the system and take other appropriate corrective action for violation of these guidelines.

Depending on the severity of the infraction, a verbal warning will be issued for the first violation. A second infraction will lead to a 30-day "tech ban," and a third violation can lead to loss of all internet privileges for the remainder of the school year.
